TEAM REQUIREMENTS & RULES

1. CATEGORIES

The cook-off categories are: **Chili, Chicken Wings, and "Wildcard"**. You may enter ANY food item in the "wildcard" category. Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each categories. A Grand Champion will be declared based on the highest scoring entry overall. There will be a people's choice award for each category. The People's choice winners will be determined by the team that collects the most "People's choice" vote tickets stubs from the crowd.

Teams may compete in one or all 3 categories.

Chicken wings- Each team is required to cook 200 portions.

Chili- Each team must cook **at least** 5 gallons of chili to enter the category.

Wildcard- Cook whatever you want. You must be able to provide 200+ servings of whatever you make. Boston butt, jambalaya, gumbo, dessert, whatever you cook. All cook off rules apply to this category.

- 2. There is no registration fee.** Each team will receive 10 tickets to sell and agree to be responsible for collecting and turning in the money owed. Checks should be made to **Dauphin Island PTO**. All ticket money must be turned in before 10 am on the day of the event. Each team will receive 4 chef's passes to the event.
- 3. ALL FOOD MUST BE COOKED ON SITE!!!!** Pre chopped vegetables purchased from a food supplier, such as Monarch foods or Jimmy Lowes, are acceptable. You need to provide your own propane cooker and fuel source, grill, fryer, pot, ingredients, etc. Please use a 1.5-2oz ladle so the chili lasts!! **Teams should also plan to bring separate ice chests for food storage and drinks. BRING ICE!!!!** We will provide serving bowls, plates, spoons, serving gloves & paper towels. BRING EVERYTHING ELSE YOU NEED!!!! . We are asking for teams to provide their own tent this year. If you are unable to, please contact me and we will find a way to assist you.

Health Department Requirements: Each team must have ONE member with a Mobile County food handler's card or a serve-safe card. You can take the test online and print the certificate. For Health department information contact Janice Spangler- 251-690-8149. **The Health department wants to see separate ice chests for food storage and drinks, a thermometer to keep the Chili at holding temperature and will not allow WOODEN stirring paddles.**

4. Team Meetings

A team meeting will be held on Thursday, February 15th at 6pm at Pirate's Bar and Grill

5. Prizes/ Awards

Trophies will be awarded for 1st-3rd places and people's choice in all three categories. A really gaudy trophy will be awarded for the overall winner.

6. Refreshments

Our Event Sponsor, Pirate's Bar and Grill, will be selling drinks at the event. Please do not pass out refreshments to the crowd. (Ice chests for cooks are allowed)
